

Lifetime Achievement Award

Lee Wimberly '75, the 2025 MSU Denver Golden Nest Lifetime Achievement Award recipient, built a remarkable 27-year career at Boeing, where he applied his philosophy and psychology studies from MSU Denver to advance projects in artificial intelligence, automation, and systems integration. Following his retirement, Wimberly became an author, publishing Exploring the Gap Between Science and Religion, a work that bridges scientific inquiry and spiritual understanding. He continues to explore these themes through new philosophical writings and ongoing coursework at MSU Denver, where he recently presented his developing theory, "An Observer-centric Philosophy of Science."





The MSU Denver Alumni Association remains committed to responsible financial stewardship and maximizing resources to support students and alumni programs. In FY25, the Association maintained strong fiscal health across its three primary funds—the Alumni Association Board Endowment, Alumni Association Scholarship Fund, and Alumni Association General Fund. 2024 Season Summary:

In 2024, the Alumni Association completed it's sixth season as the official non-profit partner of the

Colorado Rockies Foundation facilitating the 50/50 Raffle at all Rockies home games. The association is responsible for recruiting, training and scheduling volunteers to sell raffle tickets throughout the games and in exchange, the association donates a portion of the raffle profits back to MSU Denver programs, departments and scholarships. The association splits 50% of the jackpot with the Colorado Rockies Foundation.

The 2024 Raffle raised a total of \$189,661 for MSU Denver programs, clubs, and teams, with volunteers working 3,024 hours to sell tickets during the season. The largest jackpot of the season was \$60,974, with the winner taking home \$30,487.
