- Select at least one General Studies or Elective course that meets the Ethnic Studies and Social Justice Requirement – see the university catalog for options.
- PSY 1800 is required for the major and can also satisfy 3 credits of the Social and Behavioral Science General Studies requirement.
- JMP 1010 is recommended as one of the two Arts and Humanities General Studies courses.
- Minor courses may be used to satisfy Elective course requirements in this plan.
- Select at least one upper division (3000 or 4000 level) elective course to meet the minimum requirement of 39 upper division credits.
- To complete this program 100% online, select General Studies and Elective courses that are offered online. However, you may select in-person courses if you choose.
