Graduate students registered exclusively for online classes will be charged tuition, Student Affairs Fee, Student Technology Fee, Metro Bond Fee, Intercollegiate Athletic Fee, and Health & Wellbeing Fee.

Auraria Bond Fee: This fee is used to support the debt service requirements of the debt financing for the Auraria Child Care Center, the Tivoli Student Union and the Auraria Event Center.

Intercollegiate Athletic Fee: Provides students with access to home athletic events and updated facilities such as gyms, weight rooms and courts. Also supports MSU Denver Athletics, including student-athlete opportunities, game-day experiences, and campus traditions that build school pride and connection across the Roadrunner community.

Tivoli Park Facility Fee: This tri-institution student-approved fee is used to fund the development, enhancement, and ongoing maintenance of the Tivoli Park/Quad, Tivoli Patio and Coffee Lounge, and future campus-wide student gathering spaces.

Clean Energy Fee: This student-approved fee is for purchasing clean, renewable, electrical power for the Auraria Campus.

Health & Wellbeing Fee: This fee funds a portion of the operating budgets of the Health Center at Auraria and the MSU Denver Counseling Center. Fees support the cost of campus safety infrastructure, medical and mental health personnel and health education. The addition of Campus Recreation now provides online-only students with access to recreation facilities, fitness classes, intramural sports, esports, outdoor recreation opportunities, wellness programming, and other resources that support physical, mental, and social well-being. The fee helps maintain and sustain wellness and recreation programs and services available to the Roadrunner community.

Metro Bond Fee: This student approved fee will provide capital financing for the construction of a new Metropolitan State University Neighborhood, student scholarships, and student equipment and classroom enhancements.

Student Affairs Fee: This fee supports student services through the following programs: Auraria Early Learning Center, Career Services, Club Sports, Center for Visual Arts, Institute for Women's Studies and Services, LGBTQ Student Resource Center, Music, Student Activities, Student Engagement and Wellness, Student Government, Student Media, Student Organization Funding, Student Travel, and Theatre.

Student Technology Fee: This fee supports a variety of technology needs including but not limited to: classroom technologies, virtual learning environments, learning management and support technologies and student computing labs.

Matriculation Fee (One-time fee): \$125 for Graduate students (charged to ALL students including non-degree seeking and students auditing courses). The matriculation fee is used to offset orientation, student ID card, and graduation costs. This fee is not included in the Tuition and Fees Table, but will appear on the billing statement.
